THE GUIDE

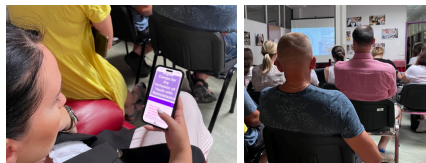
We didn't stop at local activities for kids. We also created a guide for those who want to design and run similar digital camps. Therefore, we created a multilingual guide that:

- Explains more about retinoblastoma (symptoms and treatments)
- Focuses on non-formal training for trainers (how to identify the needs of the trainers)
- Provide practicalities on creation of virtual camps (workshop proposals)
- And leads you towards the creation of your own project

The guide is available in all languages on project platform/ webiste.

DISSEMINATION EVENTS

At the end of the project [Zavod Boter](#) (Slovene partner) organised a final dissemination event in Novo mesto, reaching 40 youth stakeholders, mainly parents and social workers working with children with disabilities or vulnerabilities. The project manager presented the activities and results, and participants registered on the platform to access useful resources for future use.
